ARANGKADA PHILIPPINES INVESTMENT FORUM 2025

SEPTEMBER 25-26, 2025 | MARRIOTT GRAND BALLROOM

For more than a decade, the Arangkada Philippines forum has served as a platform for policymakers, business leaders, and investors to engage in discussions about the current investment climate, regulatory landscape, and emerging market opportunities in the country through curated panel discussions and networking opportunities.

For 2025, the Arangkada Philippines Forum hopes to deepen engagement with and between public and private sector partners by introducing more interactive opportunities for engagement.

The Arangkada Philippines Investment Program is expected to be held across 2-3 days, with one day dedicated to the traditional Arangkada Forum, which will consist of a morning plenary and afternoon breakout sessions on the JFC's Seven Big Winner Sectors to be separated into three sector clusters: (1) Agro-industrial; (2) Manufacturing, Logistics, and Infrastructure; and (3) Creative Industries and Tourism. This will be supplemented by a day of business-to-business and business-matching opportunities, and on-site tours of potential investment sites with government partners.

Rene has vast experience in both the private and public sectors. He currently serves as a consultant at Ayala Corporation (AC). Previously, Rene held the position of Senior Managing Director and Head of the Public Affairs Group. Over more than two decades with the Ayala Group, he served as CEO of seven (7) companies and held various positions on the management committees of the holding companies.

He spent 13 years with the Citibank group where he started as a management trainee and landed his first CEO position as President of City Savings Bank of the Aboitiz Group at the age of 37. Rene was Treasurer of Aboitiz Equity Ventures and Aboitiz and Company before President of City Savings Bank. In 2001, he was hired by Ayala Land to take over as CEO of Cebu Holdings Inc. and Cebu Property Ventures concurrently head of Ayala Land VisMin. He eventually occupied several other roles in Ayala Land as a member of the management committee prior to moving to Manila Water. In 2007, Rene was moved to Manila Water as COO to eventually take over as President.

In 2011, the World Economic Forum recognized him and Manila Water Company as a Sustainability Champion while he was President thereof. During his stint as MWC President and Chief Operating Officer, the company received multiple awards and was recognized as one of the Best Managed Companies in Asia, Best in Corporate Governance, one of the Greenest Companies in the Philippines and hailed as the world's Most Efficient Water Company.

As a public servant Rene served in various high-level positions, namely, Secretary of Energy, Cabinet Secretary and Secretary of Foreign Affairs. In June 2016, Rene was awarded the Order of Lakandula, Rank of Gold Cross Bayani, a Presidential award and the highest honor given to a civilian by the Republic of the Philippines. The award was President Aquino's recognition of his exemplary service during his administration.

Rene holds several notable positions. In 2024, he was the 76th President of the Management Association of the Philippines (MAP). He also serves on the Board of the Center for Family Ministries of the Ateneo de Manila and is a Board Member of the Institute for Regional Security, a Regional Organization based at Deakin University in Canberra, Australia. Furthermore, Rene has been appointed as a Private Sector Representative to the Legislative-Executive Development Advisory Council (LEDAC) through MAP, and currently serves as an Independent Director in Emperador, Inc. and a Board Member in Ateneo de Cebu.


