  - Enrolment and class opening



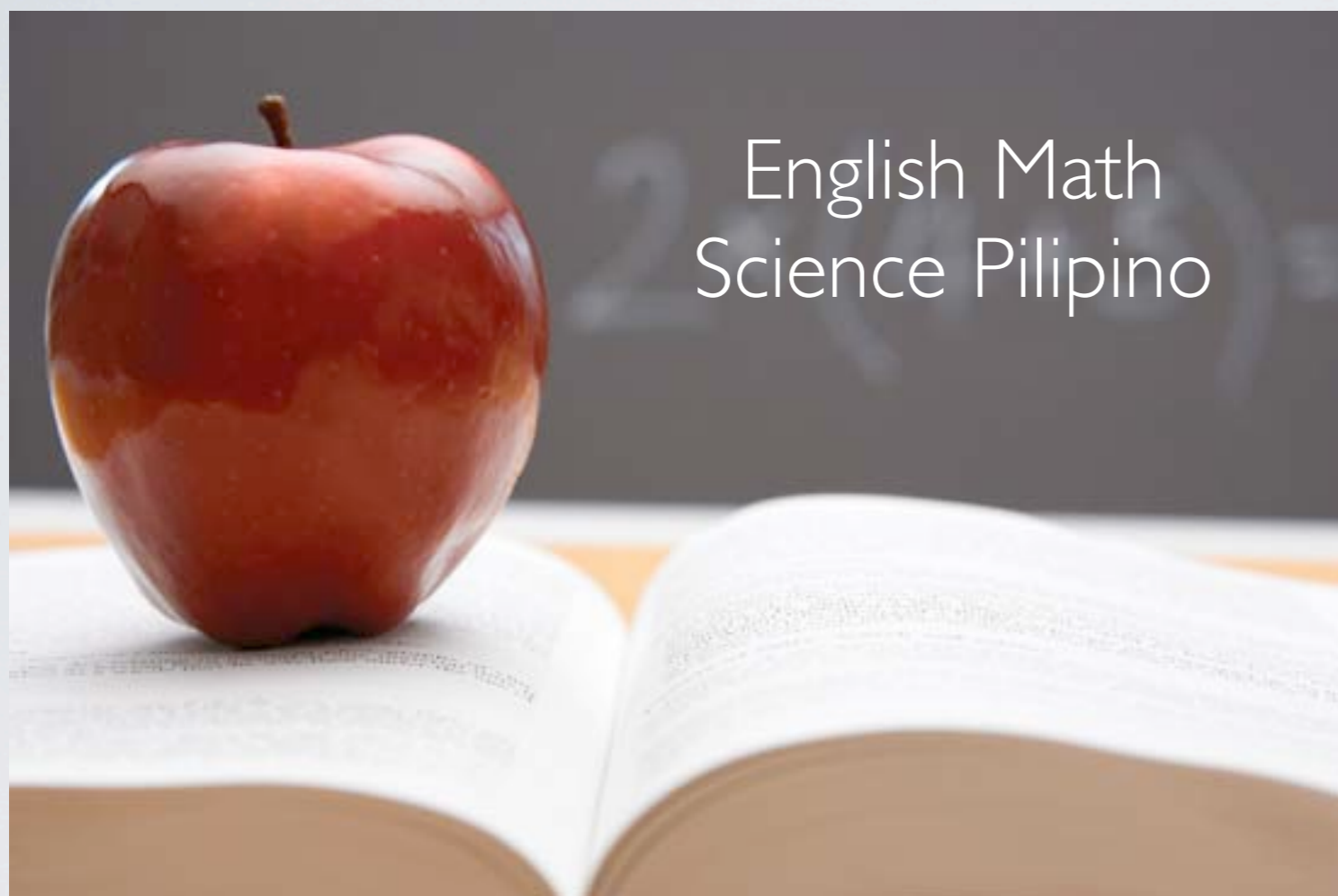

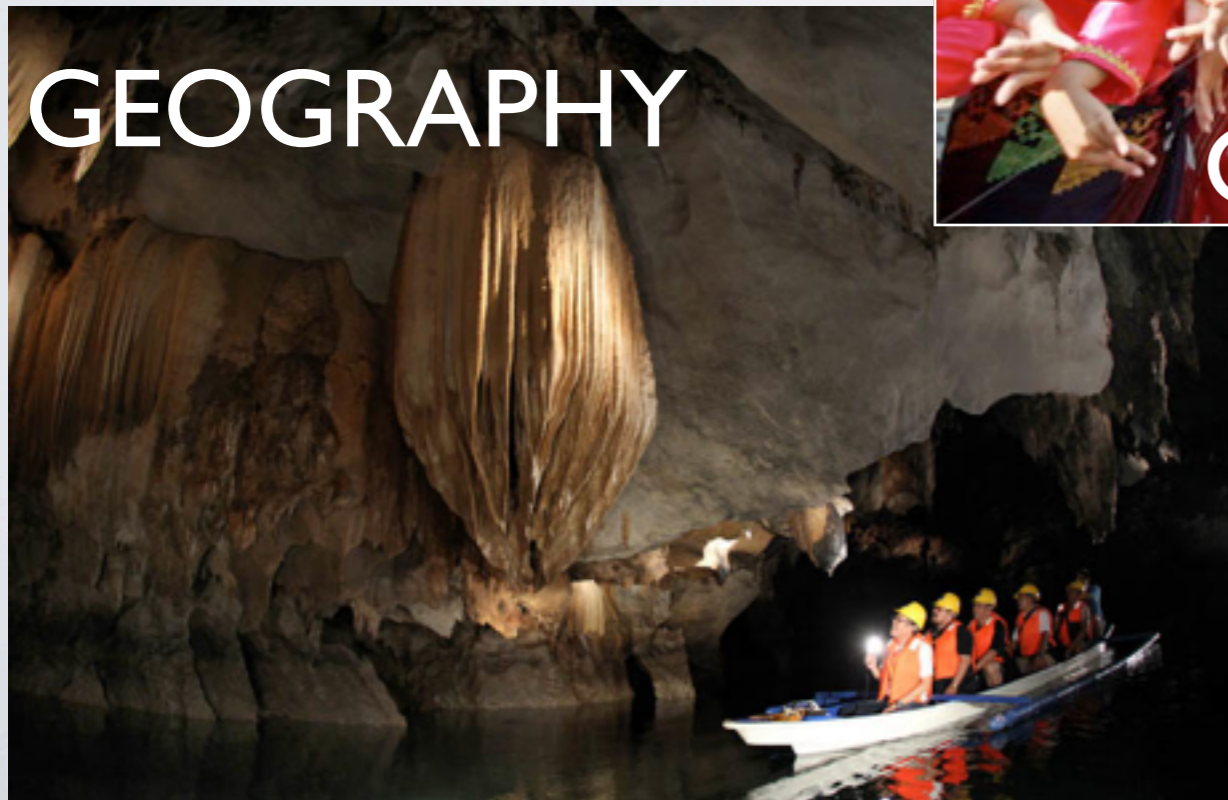
