

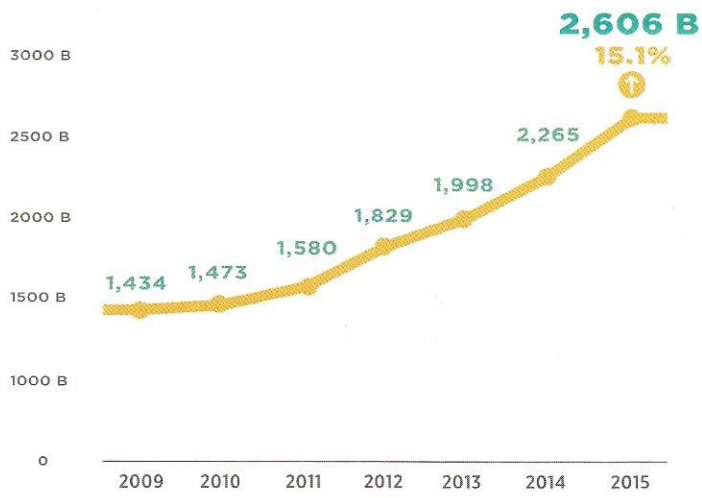
2015 National Budget

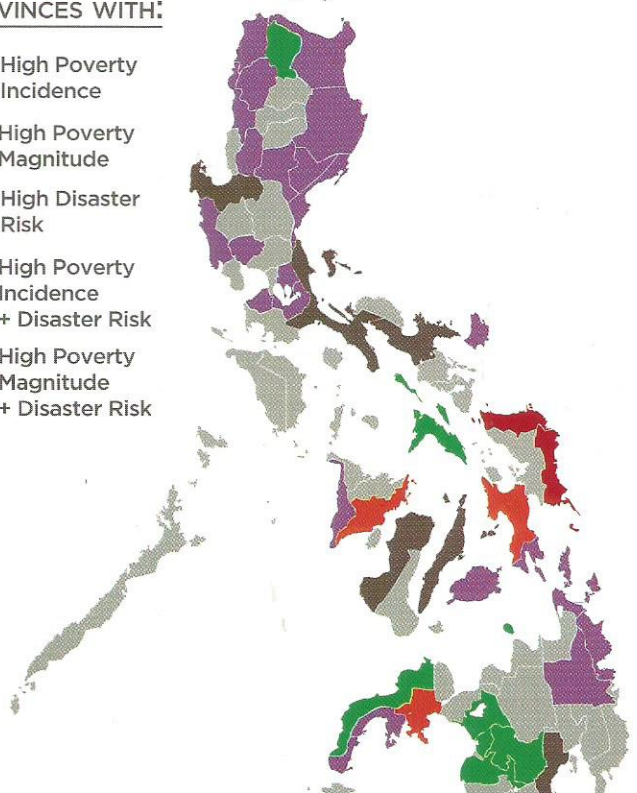
1 | This Budget increased by 15.1% from the Fiscal Year 2014 budget in order to support further economic growth.
