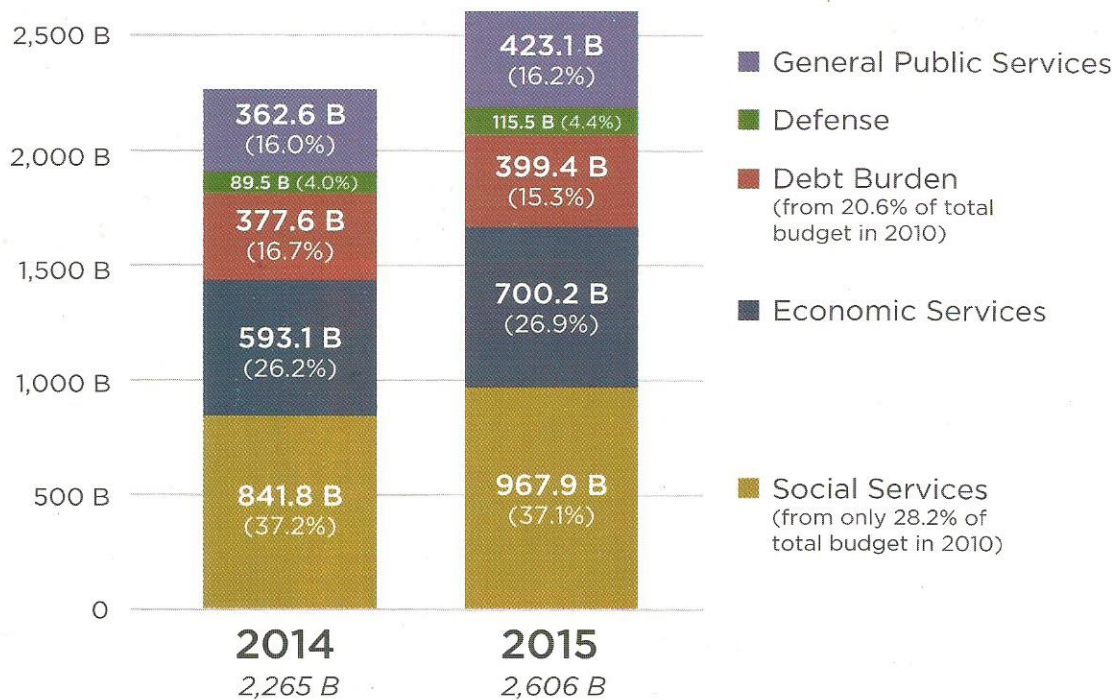


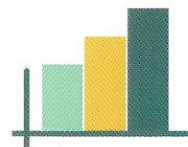
Since 2010, the Aquino Administration has been increasing the focus of the Budget on priority services that support inclusive development. Of the total proposed Budget for 2015, 37.1% will go to social services and 26.9% to economic services. Meanwhile, the share of the Debt Burden has been reduced to 15.3%.

The Budget by Sector, 2014 vs. 2015 (in Php billions)



Social Protection and Social Services

- P64.7 billion is allocated for the Conditional Cash Transfer program to support 4.4 million beneficiaries
- P37.2 billion is allocated to Health Insurance that will cover 15.5 million beneficiaries
- P52.7 billion is allocated to Basic Educational Facilities, including 31,728 new classrooms and 13,586 water and sanitation facilities



Job Creation and Economic Expansion

- P174.5 billion will be given for the DPWH Roads and Bridges Program
- P2 billion for the Training for Work Scholarship Program of TESDA to train 210, 526 workers in agri fishery, tourism, semi-conductor and electronics, among others.
- P592 million for the NAIA 1 Rehabilitation Project



Enabling Environment for Inclusive Development

- Bangsamoro Basic Law: P2.7 billion to be lodged in various NGAs
- P7.3 billion to PAMANA to implement peaceful resettlements



Climate Change Adaptation and Mitigation

- P45.1 billion for flood control, lodged under the budget of DPWH (P44.8 billion) and MMDA (P281 million)
- Air and Water Quality Programs: P139 million to ensure cleaner air and P99 million for waterways
