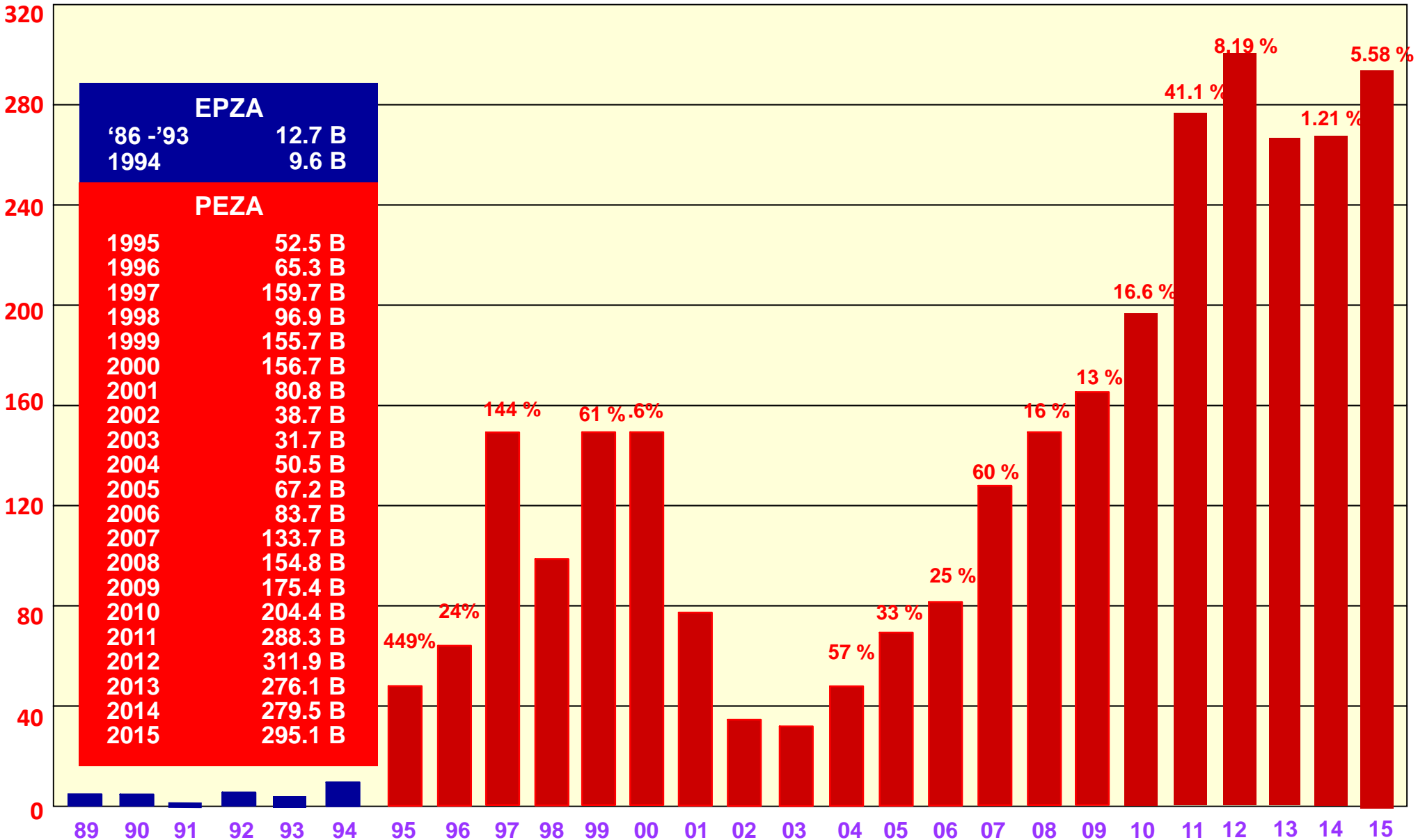

1995 – 2015 Economic Zone Investments : P 3.157 Trillion

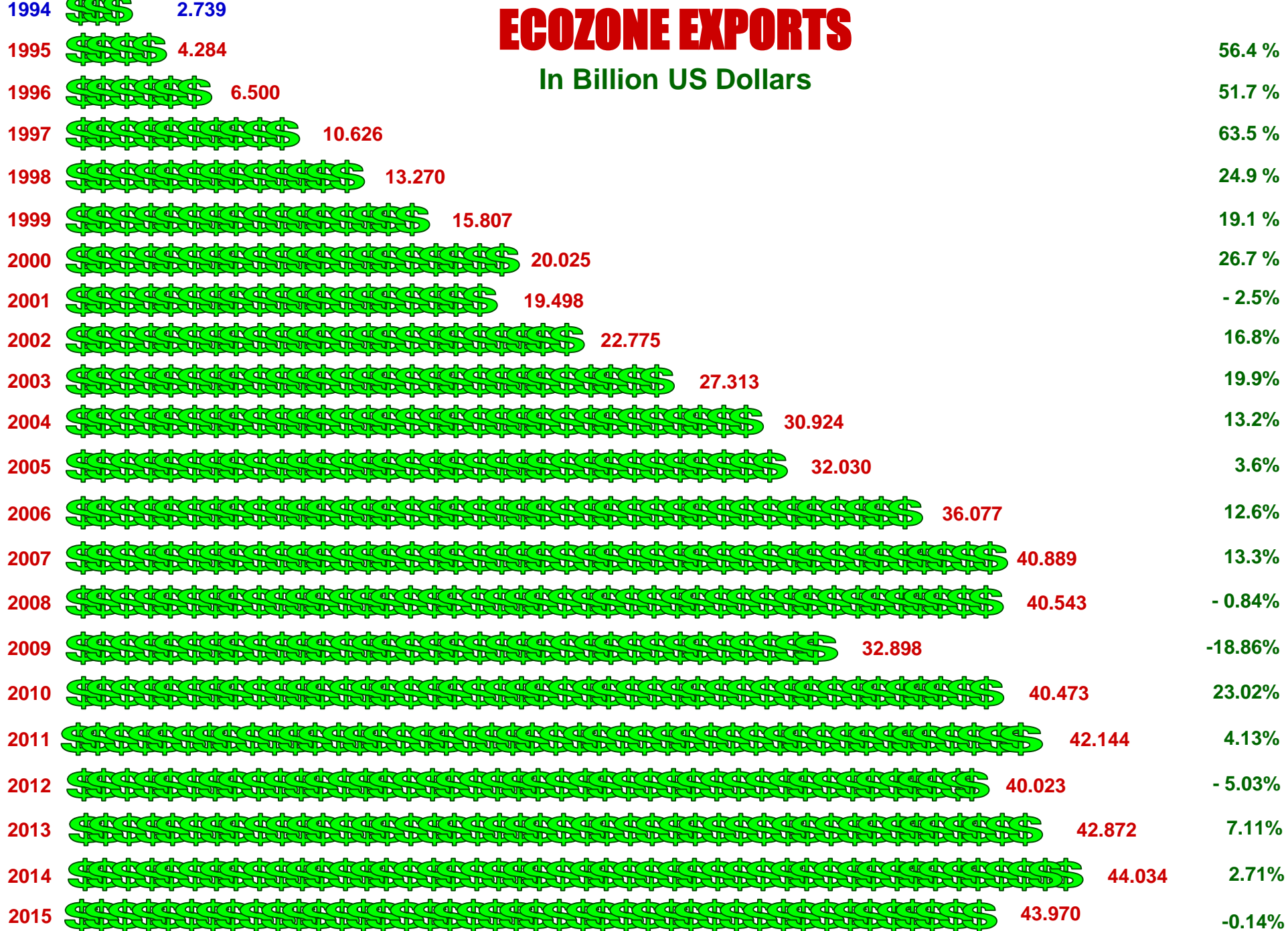

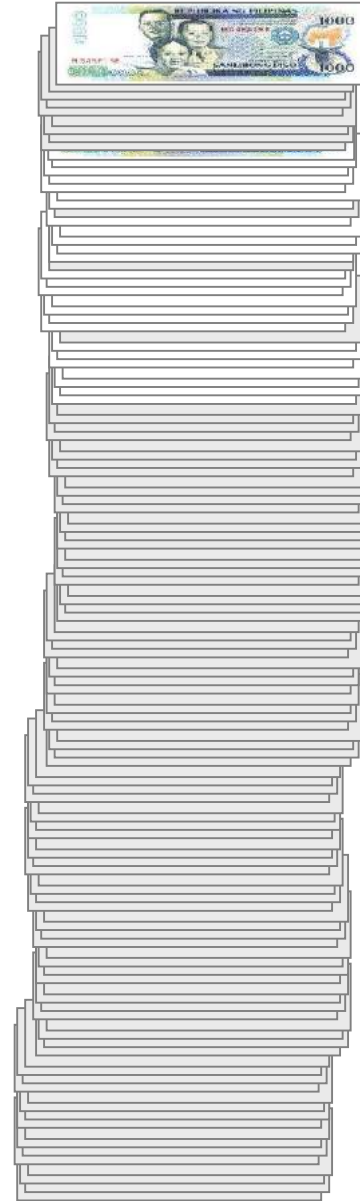
